GRAMMAR-look for 10 adjectives in the newspaper (provided for you in the last drop off), cut them out and paste to notebook paper. **Make sure you head your paper!!** **REMEMBER!!! ADJECTIVES** describe a noun or a pronoun. **EXAMPLE:** “a brave astronaut” with **BRAVE** being the adjective.

MATH-complete review wkst. 79 “Addition of Fractions” that was included in your packet from drop off. Look at the review at the top to remind you how to add with different denominators.

SOCIAL STUDIES-read Scholastic News May 11 edition “Sky’s the Limit” and answer questions on the back.
