Study Guide

- *Students need to know that the following are things of today: water runs right into our homes, we write emails on the computer, we shop for food at a store, airplanes help us go to places far away.**
- *Students need to know that the following are things of the past: we travel by wagons pulled by horses, we grow food in a garden, most families live on farms.**
- *Communication is the way people share ideas, thoughts, or information.**
- *Examples of communication are email and letters.**
- *Most of the time, people walked to places in the past.**
- *Some examples of transportation are trains, carts pulled by horses, buses, motorcycles, boats, wagons, taxis, and cars.**
- *Students need to be able to write 2 complete sentences about how people lived in the past. Their sentences may include details about how people lived at home, communicated, and went from place to place.**
